



HAMILTON MIDDLE SCHOOL AWARDS CRITERIA



<i>Opal Hamilton Nomination:</i>	Student has earned all A's every grading period, shows leadership ability and is clearly outstanding in all categories. The awards are given to two students per grade level after nominations are anonymously reviewed by a committee.
<i>Daughters of American Revolution Good Citizenship Award:</i>	Student exemplifies the qualities of honor, service, courage, leadership, and patriotism (8th grade only). Award winner is selected by teacher vote, after nominations are made based on criteria above.
<i>Distinguished Honor Roll*:</i>	Student has earned all A's for each grading period, while maintaining satisfactory conduct.
<i>Outstanding in Subject Areas:</i>	Student continues to be self-motivated, performs above and beyond requirements in subject..
<i>Outstanding in Electives:</i>	Student has excellent participation, above average performance, shows leadership ability and responsibility.
<i>Outstanding in Physical Education:</i>	Student scores high on the physical fitness test, has all A's and E's in P.E. and exemplifies REAL expectations.
<i>Honor Roll*:</i>	Student has earned no less than 4 A's and 3 B's each grading period, while maintaining satisfactory conduct.
<i>Tiger Paw:</i>	Determined, self-motivated and constantly striving to achieve high expectations.
<i>Citizenship:</i>	Student exemplifies REAL expectations and acts as a good role model. No DMC or D-Hall during the year.
<i>Spirit:</i>	Cheerfully participates in all school activities.

**6th grade Language Arts class is two periods. Therefore, the averages earned in this class will count twice in Honor Roll calculations. For example, an A in 6th grade L.A. counts as two As.*
